



The Productivity-Pay Gap

The gap between productivity and a typical worker's compensation has increased dramatically since 1979

Productivity growth and hourly compensation growth, 1948–2022



Notes: Data are for compensation (wages and benefits) of production/nonsupervisory workers in the private sector and net productivity of the total economy. "Net productivity" is the growth of output of goods and services less depreciation per hour worked.












Labor Activist Robert Owen - 1817

1835

Workers in Philadelphia organized the first general strike in North America. From 6 to 6, ten hours work and two hours for meals 1868

The US Congress

<u>passed</u> the first eighthour-day work law for
federal employees

1886

350,000 workers nationwide struck and along with the National Labor Union (NLU) <u>demanded</u> Congress to pass a law mandating the eighthour workday












Sep 25 1926: Henry Ford caves to union demands and adopts the 5-day, 40-hour work week, then acts like it was his idea.







Productivity and service provision remained the same or improved across the majority of trial workplaces.



The wellbeing of employees increased significantly across a range of indicators, from perceived stress and burnout, to work-life balance & health.



After the overwhelming success of the trial, 86% of the country's workforce are now working shorter hours or gaining the right to shorten their hours.










The world's largest four-day workweek experiment went really well

61 UK companies switched to shorter workweeks for 6 months, leading to big increases in life satisfaction and employee retention, and decreases in stress and burnout.



About 2,900 employees participated in the trial that ran from June through December 2022. 56 of 61 companies are continuing with shorter workweeks after the trial's end. Results were reported on varying scales and have been converted to percents for comparison.






